Preparatory work	Select suitable products to match the surface to be cleaned (type / square metres) and soiling.	the type of

	Fill the fresh water tank with cleaning product solution in accordance with the dosing ir For machines with an integrated dosing system, fill cold water into the fresh water tank cleaning product as needed.		
	Put up the warning sign.		
	Remove any loose dirt (dust-binding mopping or dry vacuum cleaning).		
	Wet mop any areas (e.g. corners) that cannot be reached with the machine.		
Main task	Switch on the machine and lower the suction nozzle.		
	Use the machine with suitable pads or brushes to <b>scrub-dry</b> the open area in overlapp	ing passes.	
	Perform a visual check.		
Final steps	Remove the warning sign.		
	Empty the waste water and the fresh water tank, rinse them and leave them open to dry.		
	Rinse the pads, brushes and the suction nozzle with water.		
	Replace the pads, brushes and suction lips as needed.		
	Check the battery level and recharge as needed.		
	Dispose of any waste.		
	Clean the cleaning equipment and replace as needed.
