Carpet cleaners



Benefits:

Universal basic and interval cleaner for water-resistant synthetic and wool carpets.

Can be used with both spray extraction and the carpet pad method.

Application:

For basic and intermediate cleaning of textile floor coverings.

Please note:

Wetrok Retex is designed only for carpets with a synthetic (non water-sensitive) base weave and water-resistant adhesive / substrate.

Properties:

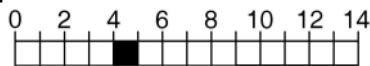
Low lather

Important ingredients:

Surfactants, solvents, chelating agent, fragrance

Storage/shelf life:

Store in original container in a cool, well-ventilated place.

Protect from frost. Keep container closed when not in use.

Shelf life (unopened): 24 months.

Recommended dosage (in cold water):



Carpet pad method

0.1 l – 0.3 l / 10 l



Spray extraction (direct)

0.1 l – 0.3 l / 10 l



Spray extraction (indirect)

0.3 l – 1 l / 10 l

Recommended application methods:

Carpet pad method

Dry or brush vacuum the textile floor covering. Remove any staining using Wetrok Karpothek. Spray cleaning solution onto textile floor covering and carpet pad and begin cleaning using circular movements of the single brush machine. Work in sections. Turn over or replace soiled pads. Brush the carpet pile with a pile brush and allow the covering to dry completely.

Carpet extraction

Dry or brush vacuum the textile floor covering. Pre-treat any stains with Wetrok Karpothek. **Direct:** Pour cleaning solution into the water tank and perform spray extraction on the floor in a single work process. Brush the carpet pile with a pile brush and allow the covering to dry completely (min. 24h). **Indirect:** Spray floor covering with cleaning solution and leave to act for approx. 10 minutes. Do not allow to dry out! Perform spray extraction on the covering using clean water. Brush the carpet pile with a pile brush and allow the covering to dry completely (min. 24h).
